Ohana Young Parents Happening In Your Community:

Ohana Young Parents is a non-profit organisation. We reach out to many young parents in West Auckland and have been running now for nearly two years. Our course runs over ten weeks, during this period our young mothers blossom into confident individuals, well equipped with the most up to date information regarding best practices for caring and educating their young babies.

We provide parenting tools that allow individual mothers to make informed decisions and create aspirations for their own future. Part of our program includes facilitating 'Building an awesome Whanau'. This is specifically designed and created by the 'Parenting Place', it looks at encouraging individuals to reflect on where they came from and what goals and parenting styles they want to adapt for their own family. We also provide first aid training and budgeting advice.

So far we have had around 80 individuals through our Ohana course, 80% of these mothers have continued on to enrol at Te Kura correspondence school completing their level 1, 2 and 3. Te Kura is extremely proud of our group and believes the successes are occurring due to the positive support they gain from us, we encourage them to aim high and succeed.

Kangatraining

Kangatraining is a babywearing postnatal workout focused on strengthening the muscles which can get stretched during pregnancy (especially the transverse abdominis and pelvic floor) and improving posture.

It is a low impact, full body workout and one which allows mums to be with their babies while improving their health and fitness level, as we wear out babies for most of the workout in safe baby carriers (which allow proper development of the hips, spine and appropriate head support).

Mums can start from 6 weeks post-partum or 12 weeks if they have had a C-section. Dads are welcome too; they can start classes once bubs is 6 weeks old.

Kangatraining is a low impact interval danced based program where the baby is the star!

No babysitter required and don't worry if you don't have a carrier there are loan ones available.
